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## PTO Meeting Summary

11/14/17- There were 12 members in attendance.

### 1. Introductions

7 parents and 2 teachers were in attendance.

### 2. Principal Report

Dr. Morgan praised the potluck, bookfair, and veterans day celebration. She said that the IB response had been uploaded to IB with no clear timeline for response. She said we have a new administrative assistant, Shelley Donahue, in the front office. She reported that at a teacher meeting there was discussion of incorporating IB into learning Festival and keeping it learning focused. There was some discussion of Twitter and the best way to use social media to reach parents. Dr. Morgan mentioned that she planned to send a survey out in January to parents.

### 3. Treasurer Report

Kerry McGarry reported \$260 from Buccetos Dine-for-dollars and \$219 from skate night in September, and is still waiting for October's money. She also reported that Art to Remember made \$4200 which will go directly to the art program.

### 4. State of the PTO and Upcoming Events

Hopi Stosberg explained that she had been working on the U's News newsletter because our editor had to resign. The newsletter responsibility may be moved to the school office staff as it had been in the past. There was discussion of the Boy Scout request for a charter, with a vote coming to the whole PTO probably next semester. The PTO bylaws need to be updated and a committee formed to look at that and 501c3 status. Events coming up for monthly Dining for dollars and skate night. Next PTO meeting will be December 12 and will cover curriculum. Also, the date of the Family Fitness Night was changed to March 7<sup>th</sup>.
